UCF STATEMENT OF COLLECTION AND USE OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS

The University of Central Florida (UCF) must notify individuals of the circumstances that require or authorize the collection and use of social security numbers ("SSN"). Florida Statute 119.71(5) specifically authorizes UCF to collect SSNs when required by law or where the SSN is imperative in the performance of its duties. The following are the general scenarios under which UCF will collect and use social security numbers:

Required by the Internal Revenue Code (see sections 3402(f)(2)(A) and 6109 and implementing regulations); see also Florida Statute 119.071(5)(a)6 (authorized)
Required by the Internal Revenue Code (see sections 3406) and 6109 and implementing regulation); permitted by 119.071(5)
Immigration and Control Act of 1986 – 8 USC 1324 (required)
Higher Education Act (HEA) of 1965 (see Sections 483 and 484) (required; authorized); Florida Statute 1001.706(5)(d) and 1008.31(3) (authorized)
See Florida Statute 119.071(5)(a) and (5)(a)6.f (authorized)
See Florida Statute 119.071(5)(a) and (5)(a)6.f. (authorized)
Higher Education Act (HEA) of 1965 (see Sections 483 and 484) (required; authorized)
Higher Education Act (HEA) of 1965 (see Sections 483 and 484); Hope Scholarship and Lifelong Learning Credits legislation (Public Laws 105-34, 107-16); see Florida Statute 119.071(5) (required; authorized)
Required by the Internal Revenue Code (see sections 170 and 6050L and implementing regulations)

To minimize the use of SSNs in campus operations, UCF assigns each employee and student a unique university-generated identification number (PID) for use in day-to-day operations. SSN's are otherwise confidential and will be securely maintained. SSN's will not be disclosed for any other reasons unless required by law or a court order.
